

How to install Greek keyboard in Windows 10

The Greek keyboard looks like this (in grey font is the English char on the keyboard) –



You can mark the positions of the characters in Greek.


1. Go to the start button at the bottom left of the Desktop screen and select "Settings"




2. You will see the Windows Settings screen open up – select "Time & Language"




3. A new window will open up like this where on the left you can select "Language"




4. A new window will open-up where you can press the plus sign on the left of "Add a preferred language"



5. A new window will open-up where at the top you can enter the word "Greek"



6. After you type the word "Greek" (instead of scrolling down), just select the Greek language entry «Ελληνικά» and press "Next" then the "Install" button at the bottom.



When you finish installing you will find a new link in the Task bar in Windows at the bottom. This link looks like this –



From there you can select the input language. Press on the "EN English" and select English, press on "EL Greek (Greece)" and select Greek. Then you can type Greek anywhere in Windows.

We recommend that you leave the default language as English in your computer.

Greek accent (Tonos/Tóvoς) –

The Greek accent is placed on the Semi-colon button on the Greek keyboard.

- In Windows, press the semi-colon first and then the vowel.
- In Apple devices press the vowel first and then the semi-colon in the Greek keyboard.
